Abstract

This document presents the adopted record of the Sixth Meeting of the Commission for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources held in Hobart, Australia, 1987. Major topics discussed at this meeting include: financial administration, assessment and avoidance of incidental mortality to Antarctic marine living resources, review of the report of the Scientific Committee, review of existing Conservation measures and adoption of three new Conservation measures, submission of fine-scale data to CCAMLR, establishment of a system of observation and inspection of fishing and research activities in the Convention Area, compliance with Conservation Measures in force, development of a conservation strategy for Antarctic marine living resources, and cooperation with other international organisations. The report of the Standing Committee on Administration and Finance is appended.
