

Abstract

This document presents the adopted record of the Eleventh Meeting of the Commission for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources held in Hobart, Australia from 26 October to 6 November 1992. Major topics discussed at this meeting include: review of the Report of the Scientific Committee, assessment and avoidance of incidental mortality of Antarctic marine living resources, current operation of the System of Inspection and establishment of the CCAMLR Scheme of International Scientific Observation, compliance with conservation measures in force, review of existing conservation measures and adoption of new conservation measures including precautionary catch limitations on krill by small statistical area, consideration of proposed new fisheries, and cooperation with other international organisations including the Antarctic Treaty System. The Reports of the Standing Committee on Administration and Finance and the Standing Committee on Observation and Inspection are appended.
