It was subsequently purchased by the current owner and re-flagged to New Zealand in early 2008.

2008. ² Since 2008 the vessel has been New Zealand flagged for operations in CCAMLR exploratory fisheries. At the conclusion of operations in CCAMLR exploratory fisheries the vessel flags to Australia to fish in waters under Australian jurisdiction. The vessel is required to flag back to New Zealand before New Zealand issues a licence for the vessel to operate in CCAMLR exploratory fisheries.
